





Cross Cutting Issues in the Curriculum




College integrates crosscutting issues relevant to professional ethics, gender, human values, environment and sustainability into the curriculum. Some of the steps taken are below:

- 1. GENDER: Numbers of programs are conducted for women and girl students in the campus. The Chhatra samiti organizes programs on Woman Empowerment, Laws for Woman, Women's Day.
































### **CATERING TO STUDENT DIVERSITY**


